


### Why are we developing the front of house?

The governors and school have been working closely with Lancashire County Council to develop the entrance to the school. The purpose of this works is to:

- Keep children and pedestrians safe. The car park and entrance to the school will be separate from each other.
- Add security to the front entrance. The new office and secure lobby will meet people as they enter the building.
- Improve and modernise the building's appearance to be more in line with the great things happening at our school.
- Re-landscaping the grounds at the front of school to make better use of the area.

### What will happen to the staff car park?

Half of the staff carpark will be out of action as the contractors use it for their compound. The carpark continues to be for staff only and cars will not be able to drop off in this space. We have given the contractors this space so that there is no impact on local parking or roads with their vehicles and deliveries.

### Will this have an impact on clubs?

Yes. Unfortunately, I have had to make the decision to not have after school clubs for the first half of the term. This is due to complications of children leaving safely. Activ8 have agreed to continue, with children brought out by their staff at the end of the session. WOOSH will continue as normal but collections will involve buzzing at the double doors in to the hall.

### How will this impact on dropping off and collecting children?

As long as your child is in school at the correct time and collected at the end of the day then it won't. The contractors will not be having an impact on either of the gates used to get into the playground, so children will go to class and be sent home at the end of the day in the same way.

If your child is late to school then it will take more time to get them in. You will need to walk them to the double doors by the school hall, press the temporary buzzer and wait for a member of staff. This will take more of your time so please be punctual at the start of the day. If you need to collect a child during the day (for example a dentist appointment) then the process will be the same. It will take longer to collect so please make appointments outside school hours for your own sake.

Deliveries during the day will also be using this secure but time consuming method of entering the school.
