## Remote Learning: Imagination Station



Remote learning is to be used in the event of your child being unable to attend school e.g. whilst self-isolating awaiting a test result. This may only be needed for a few days or for 14+ days, and the lessons will support the learning and topics being taught this half-term in class. Children should also continue to read regularly and practise their phonics on Phonics Play. Children can share their learning with their teacher on Seesaw or Tapestry.

### Communication and Language

**Play;** make time to sit, play and talk with your child. Get out their favourite characters/ toys and create imaginative stories together. Extend this by creating a piece of writing or art around their play.

Grab a pot of Play Doh, pop on some music and ask your child to show you their **Dough Disco** moves. **Complete daily** to strengthen fine motor skills for writing (for tips see Dough Disco YouTube).
