

Home Expectations on Remote/Home Learning

During lockdown children will be learning at home wherever possible. Lessons will be provided through the Seesaw app and will focus on new learning and the consolidation and practise of knowledge and skills in Maths and English as well as a topic lesson. There are 3 videos from class teachers every day explaining and directing learning. All children are expected to access and complete the 3 specific areas of learning every day and to post their work on Seesaw. There may be additional activities and learning which could be used throughout the week.

The timetable below shows a structure for the expected learning over the week and should be used to timetable each day.
