Remote learning is to be used in the event of your child being unable to attend school e.g. whilst self-isolating awaiting a test result. This may only be needed for a few days or for 14 days, and the lessons will support the learning and topics being taught this half-term in class. Children should also continue to read regularly and practise their phonics on Phonics Play. Children can share their learning with their teacher on Seesaw or Tapestry.
