Our topic 'Wet and Wild' is about the things that live on Earth. A good activity is to get out and about and see what they notice. Talk about what you find and the questions they raise.

Give them some responsibilities to look after plants, animals or help with younger siblings.

Count items together. Ask questions like, how many are left? How many are hidden? We are looking at numbers to 20 and some addition facts for numbers up to 10.
