Dear Parents/Carers,

Below are details of what the children will need to take with them, times of trains and a guide to some of the activities planned.

Clothes

We will be doing a lot of walking and the children need to be comfortable. Therefore, we encourage them to wear sporty clothes that are light weight for their bag and trainers.

Bags

They should have a rucksack with their kit in that they can carry around with them because we will not always be able to store our bags while going to a place (see below). No suitcases or carry cases are allowed.

In the bag:

- Toiletries- school are going to supply so that children do not need to carry
- Hairbrush
- Toothbrush
- Pyjamas x1
- Underwear x2
- Changes of clothes x2
- Sun Cream
- Rain coat (or may be wearing on the day- lightweight)
- Cap/hat (wear on day 1)
- Water Bottle (filled with water for first day)- this is essential as they will be thirsty throughout the trip and can refill it
- Some snacks crisps, biscuits, drink
- Medication (Inhalers. Adult distributed medication to be given to office prior)
- Towel (lightweight)

Outside the bag:

- Carrier bag of packed lunch with drinks/snacks for the train journey
(in a carrier bag which can be discarded)
