Last term, we enjoyed reading Bumblebear and writing about Harry the Happy Mouse and making hats and pictures to retell the story. We particularly enjoyed learning outside the classroom with Miss Hulse and visiting Fairfield Orchard on a sunny day in autumn to learn about changes in the seasons and the geography of our local area.
