## The Warsaw Uprising

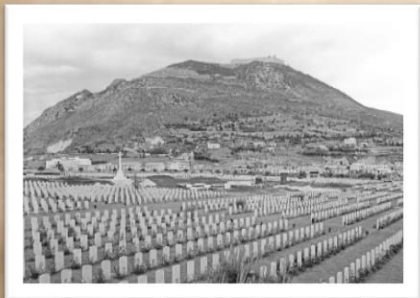
(01.08-03.10.1944) It was an armed uprising against the German troops occupying Warsaw. It was the largest battle fought during World War II by an underground organisation. It was fought against the Germans and the USSR. Poles wanted to liberate the capital before the arrival of the Red Army, hoping that this would strengthen the country and stop Stalin's process of sovietising Poland. There were around 16,000 Polish deaths, 20,000 wounded and 15,000 taken prisoner.



## The Battle at Monte Cassino

This battle in Italy was fought over the span of 5 months (17.01-19.05.1944) and ended in a success from the allied forces. There were thousands wounded and 923 deaths from the Polish Military Corps alone and in the end, this corps, under the command of Władysław Anders, raised the Polish flag amongst the ruins of the monastery.

Fun fact: A Syrian bear named Wojtek fought on the Polish side of this battle delivering artillery!
