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Dear Parents/ Carers,

Re: London Trip/ Key Dates

Below are details of what the children will need to take with them, times of trains and a guide to some of the activities planned.

Clothes

We will be doing a lot of walking and the children need to be comfortable. Therefore, we encourage them to wear sporty clothes that are light weight for their bag and trainers.

Bags

They should have a rucksack with their kit in that they can carry around with them because we will not always be able to store our bags while going to a place (see below). **No suitcases or carry cases are allowed.**
