The Judges' Lodgings Museum is located on Castle Hill, overlooking Church Street and is a two-minute walk from Lancaster Castle.

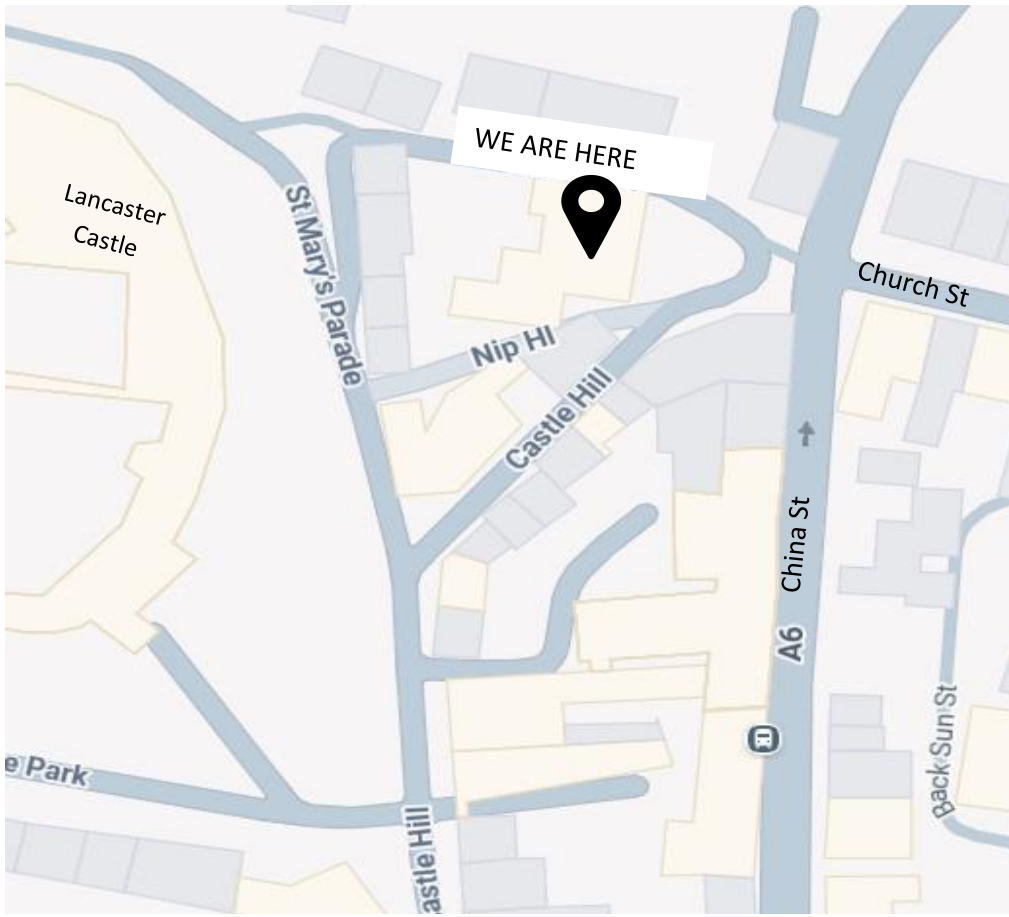
