This term, we are looking forward to...

This half term, our topic is **Magic Time Machine**. We will be learning about different periods of time from the past including the moon landing, dinosaurs, old toys and the 1980s (living memory.) Here, we will be exploring artefacts from the past and enhancing our learning throughout all areas of the curriculum. We will also be finding out all about winter and discovering how the world changes from season to season in our forest school sessions.

Next half term, our topic is **Growing!** Throughout these weeks, we will be learning about spring, new life and growing lots of plants including grass heads and some lovely plants to enhance our senses. We will taste and try lots of different fruit and vegetables and explore them in different ways. One of the most exciting things that will happen is that we will have some eggs in an incubator that will be hatching so we will be very busy taking care of some baby chicks! Throughout the spring term, we will also be continuing to take part in daily phonics lessons and practising our blending and segmenting skills as well as maths.

Key Vocabulary

- Behaviour for learning vocabulary: **determined, effort, positive**
- Maths vocabulary: **greater, more, less, fewer, heavy, light, longer, shorter**
- Phonics words, **phoneme, grapheme, digraph, build, blend, smooth read, segment**
- Book words: **characters, setting, author, illustrator, fiction (story), non-fiction (information)**
- We are working on asking questions using **when, what, why, how** and using conjunction words in our speech **and, because** and **when**
